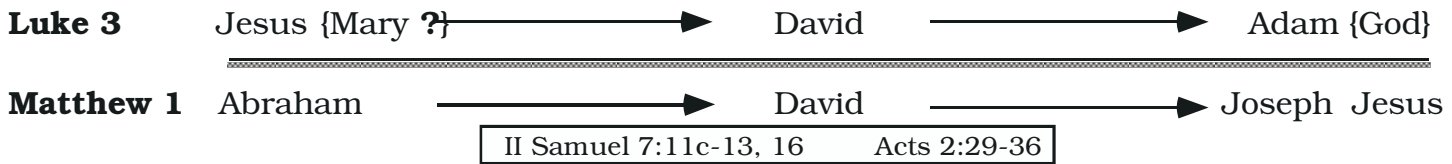
A Royal Genealogy

 - Gen 5:3-32; 11:10-26 [LXX]
 - I Chr 1:1-4, 24-27; 2:1-15; 3:5-24;
 - Ruth 4:13-21



- * Luke shows the connection of Adam, the father of all mankind, with Jesus.
- * Close to distant.
- * Human lineage.
- * Traced through Mary's line, the blood relative of Jesus, (though others say through another of Joseph's relatives).

- * Matthew shows the connection of Abraham, the father of the Jews, with Jesus.
- * Distant to close.
- * Royal lineage (not through Jehoiachin)
- * Traced through Joseph, Jesus' legal guardian.
