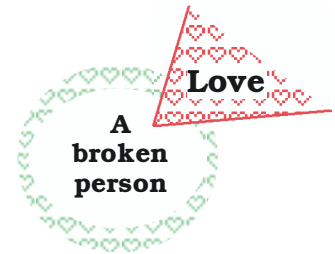
An Encounter with Love

What changed this man?

- Hardened against society's rejection
- Long time as an outcast
- Isolated with other sinners



Observations of Zaccheus

- Named Zaccheus
- A tax collector
- A chief tax collector
- He was rich
- He was small (i.e. short)
- Wanted to see Jesus
- Suffered ridicule to see Jesus
- Rejected as an outcast in society
- Convinced of the poverty of stealing
- Vowed to give away his riches
