10:4-5 Salvation is only for all who believe.

10:6-9 Salvation is for only for those who believe certain things about Christ.

10:10-11 Salvation is for all kinds of people - whoever calls upon Him.

An Intricate Relationship

Romans 6:6-10

(Deut 30:11-17)

* FAITH DEMANDED {Ro 10:6-7}

These verses are 'faith' verses. They are regarding that which we cannot scientifically prove. They are not based on what we can do either. It is resting in the work of another.

* FAITH DISCOVERED {Ro 10:8}

It is the message you are hearing.
It is the word of faith which you can hear.

* FAITH DELIVERED {Ro 10:9-10}

Confession of Jesus as Lord

Belief that God raised Jesus from the dead.

By being of faith rather than works, it opens up to the Gentiles and others who were never given the Law.

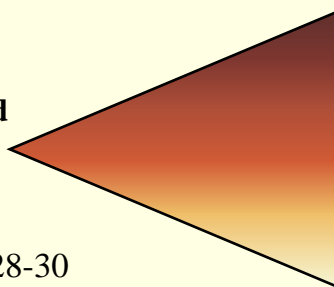
Justification by faith is proving much more than the means one is saving but also as to who can be saved.
