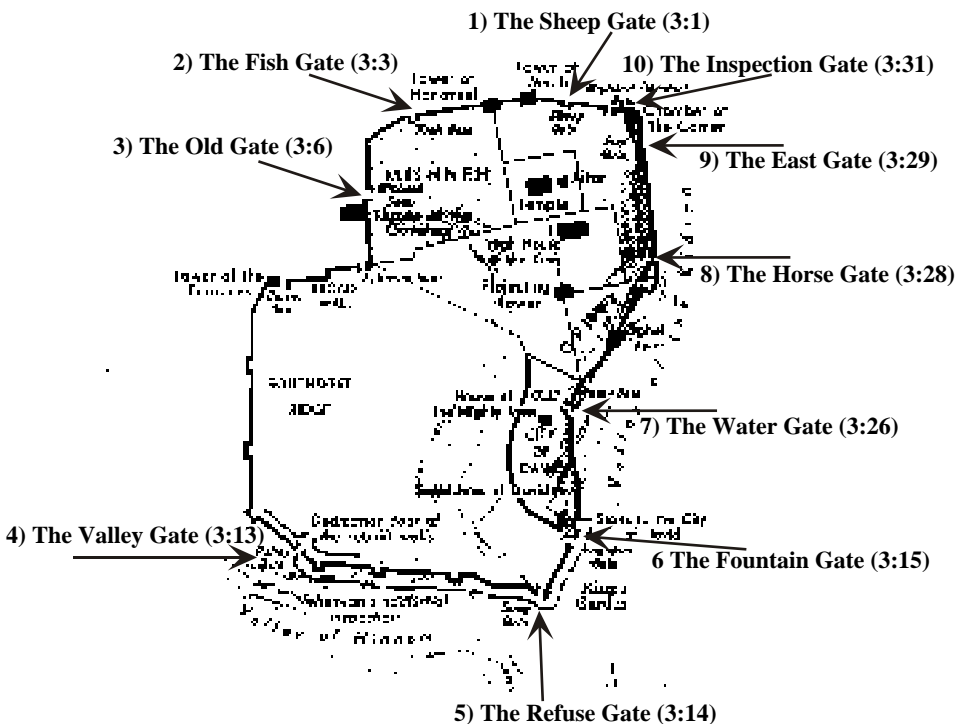
Scale of Miles
