For example, Psalm 119:65 says, "Thou hast **dealt well with** Thy servant, O LORD, according to Thy word." I can circle 'dealt well' and write, "The Psalmist confidently looks back on his life and sees how God has in so many ways blessed his life." There are several areas of confidence found in this one verse like the ones below. For the purpose of this exercise, write at least one indication of the Psalmist's confidence for each verse.

<p><u>35</u> Make me walk in the path of Thy commandments, For I delight in it.</p>	
<p><u>36</u> Incline my heart to Thy testimonies, And not to dishonest gain.</p>	
<p><u>37</u> Turn away my eyes from looking at vanity, And revive me in Thy ways.</p>	
<p><u>38</u> Establish Thy word to Thy servant, As that which produces reverence for Thee.</p>
