Do pray for continued good health as we have no microphone so our voices must project to the back of the new church. Although I could speak less loud (not many understand English), I get so excited that my voice still is vigorously excited.

My theme for these many messages is that we start with what we have. It is always enough. This means, even with failure, that we can start anew and live out the rest of our days to the glory of the Lord. Start where we are but move forward in God's strength. I am so thankful to our Lord that His message is so good and glorious.

Continue praying for 2-4 messages a day for the next six days that God might wonderful use them to build up his people in these places.
